The Access 3000 Management Terminal for Windows® integrates with the CSCB 5,000 user system master or the C3EK 1,500 user encoder to deliver full supervisory management of the Access 3000 paging system. In addition its key functions include user and team management, enhanced call logging and paging, making day-to-day operation of Access 3000 quicker, simpler and more effective.

Simplified searching

The database management features have been simplified. When creating a new user or team record the Management Terminal offers you the next available user or team number. You can now enter a user directly into a team and the system tells you what teams are available so you can click and make your selection.

Enhanced database records

No longer does the system just store paging names and numbers; the database has been enhanced to include, job title, location information, phone and fax numbers, email addresses and if required a field for notes and memos.

Improved wide-area dial out facilities

You do not have to make multiple entries in multiple databases to create a new wide-area paging user. Where possible, complex operations have been removed or simplified, making day-to-day system management easier.

Enhanced call logging

The call logging facilities have also been enhanced. Using different filters, you can analyse multiple call scenarios or look up detailed information on the call, such as when it was made, from which device the call was sent and what type of message was sent. This makes it easier to examine time critical events. More importantly, the call logger still provides a complete audit trail of all paging activity on the system.

New paging features

Flexible paging options allow rapid initiation of paging calls. You can page from any Management Terminal database; just select the user or team you wish to page and click on the send key. As with all Access 3000 paging systems, the team call facility incorporates an emergency override ensuring instant message delivery.

Password protection

In order to maximise system security, the new Management Terminal includes new and improved password protection features, allowing you to control access rights and levels, from paging to full database management and system configuration.

Improved print controls

The Management Terminal includes improved printing facilities. Header and footer text enables automatic entry of organisation names making entry of descriptive text quick and easy.

C3CB system master integration

By integrating the Management Terminal with the C3CB system master, the Access 3000 expands enabling up to 5,000 users, 100 teams, 992 closing contacts and sending messages of up to 1,000 characters. In addition the C3CB system master supports automatic hot standby whereby changes made to the database made in the main Access 3000 will automatically update the paging database in the standby Access 3000, maximising system security.
